Equipped not Exempted

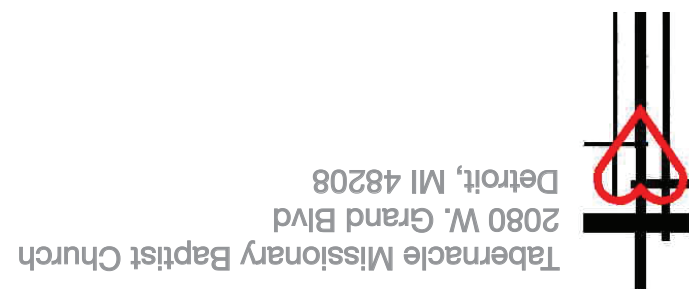

THE CHRISTIAN AND THE GREAT COMMISSION

Jesus gave the command in this passage after he had been raised from the dead. You will recall the events Leading up to his crucifixion; how Jesus' body was placed in Joseph's new tomb. You will remember that Jesus was raised from the dead after having been in the grave for three days. Early Sunday morning Mary and some of the other women had gone to the tomb to anoint the body of Jesus and when they arrived there he had risen.

At this particular time we find Jesus giving some instructions to his disciples. There were only eleven at this time. You remember, Judas had hung himself and his replacement had not yet been chosen.

Although this command was given to the disciples who later were called apostles, I want to explore with you the part I think Christians today play in this great commission. Is the responsibility for proclaiming the good news that Christ is risen left solely to the clergy? What responsibility do you and I have in this reconciling process that Jesus has commanded? Can we be comfortable in coming to church on Sunday morning and listening to the preacher preach and then go home to our regular routine for the rest of the week until next Sunday? I want to challenge you to take another look at the role all Christians play in the evangelistic thrust that Jesus mandated.

"The emphasis is on mobilizing Christians. Every Christian becomes an evangelist. While traditional evangelism seeks to multiply the number of listeners, through the mobilization of the church we seek to multiply the number of evangelists by getting into the experience, motivation and service of each believer. Each Christian is trained, motivated, and incorpor-ated into a definite program of witness" (Coggins, Pg. 51)

In Matthew 28:19 we understand that disciples are made - not Born which is the title of a book by Walter Henrichsen. We are reminded by Paul to "be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus, and the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable men who will also be qualified to teach others. (II Tim. 2:1-2)

"Again Jesus said 'Peace be with you as the Father has sent me, I am sending you'." (John 20:21)

Eugene L. Smith sums up this passage like this:

"If there is any one point at which our human part in the Christian mission begins, it is with this word of Christ. He had sent the disciples out before, and he had sent the seventy to go out two by two. That was before the Crucifixion and the Resurrection, however, from this moment, those who witnessed in the early church witnessed to the Resurrection. This witness is still central in the Christians' affirmation about Gods' action in Christ. The action of Christ in sending out disciples at this moment is set in the meaning of his own Crucifixion and Resurrection. Thus he says to us, as he said to the first disciples, 'as the Father has sent me, even so send I you'. None of us want to be sent that way. Yet, partici-pation in the Christian mission means being sent as Christ was sent."

# Writer's Ministry - Deacon's Lesson

**Lesson 6: Walking Together in Christian Love**

**Scripture:** Galatians 5:16-26 "But if ye be led by the Spirit, ye are not under the law" (Galatians 5:18).

**Goal:** To embrace and fulfill our covenant relationship with God and one another.

**Objective:** To understand how the Holy Spirit enables us to walk in Christian love.

**Introduction:**

In the first five lessons, we learned who we are as the Body of Christ. We understood that the covenant is a both a solemn and joyful reminder of our commitment to grow in Christ. In the lessons that follow, we will take a deeper look at what that means in practical terms. What behaviors, attitudes and actions clearly demonstrate that we have entered into this covenant relationship with God and one another? In other words, what are the signs of a church and its believers that are growing and maturing in Christ?

In Ephesians 4:12-16, Paul writes to the church at Ephesus and points out our corporate responsibility to perfect (equip) and to build up the church. God gifts each believer to play an integral role in helping the body of Christ in the maturation process. Corporately we encourage each other so we can engage in the work of ministry; we build up each other so that we can stand against false ideologies that threaten to pull the church away from the truth of God, our salvation in Christ, and the "kingdom" work that is ours to do. Sadly, so few of our churches are engaged in equipping and building each other up and the work of the ministry has fallen to the wayside. As we study together, we will be challenged to examine ourselves both individually and corporately. "Living as people of the Covenant exemplifies God's will being done on earth as it is in heaven. But this does not come about accidentally or automatically or by our might. To walk together in Christian love requires the aid of the Holy Spirit." Join us as we discover what it means and how to make prayerful application to our lives.

**Walking in the Flesh:**

To "walk" means to live or to continue in a habitual life style. The word, "flesh" denotes the sinful or earthly nature of mankind. Walking after the flesh is contrary to the will of God and it leads the believer to sinful behavior. This sinful behavior undermines our testimonies to others and further weakens the Christian community.

There are two natures in Christians that are always warring against each other—the flesh and the Spirit. "For the flesh lusts against the Spirit and the Spirit against the

flesh and these are contrary to one another". (Gal. 5:17) As Christians, our fleshly nature has been crucified with Christ (Gal. 5:24-25) and should no longer has dominion over us. Christ was the atonement for sins and we have been delivered from the penalty and power of sin. However, Satan is relentless and attempts to hinder our spiritual growth. He is like a roaring lion seeking whom he can devour. (I Peter 5:8) So we must be aware of his tactics and try to avoid the temptations and contentious behaviors (hatred, envy, strife and jealousy) that result from yielding to the flesh.

Flesh, operating in a Christian, attempts to develop a self-centered image and not one centered in the believer's identity in Christ. If we succumb, it will hurt and interfere with God's highest purpose, to manifest Himself through us. Some common characteristics of the flesh are:

1. Flesh is a controller. It aims to keep God at a distance. It may control our emotions as demonstrated by a critical attitude, anger, hostility, and manipulation.
2. Flesh captures us into destructive ways of thinking. "There is a way which seems right to a man, but its end is the way of death" (Proverbs 14:12).
3. Flesh is proud. People operating according to the flesh have a tremendous drive to exalt themselves to meet their needs for significance, acceptance, value, and recognition.

What are some of the problems that arise when a church is walking after the flesh? Paul's letters to the various churches gives us an accurate picture. In the Corinthian Church, there were problems with spiritual immaturity, immorality, divisions, jealousy, envy, lawsuits, and the misuse of spiritual gifts. The Galatians were trading the liberty gained through the grace of God for ceremonial rituals of Old Testament legalism. The Colossian Church was being divided by false ideologies and doctrines that led to the creation of "super saints" who felt they had special knowledge (the Gnostics) and therefore, were superior to their other brothers and sisters. When we are led by the flesh we become susceptible to chaos, perverse thinking and ideologies, pride, and arrogance that destroy any evidence of the love, harmony, and unity that is associated with being in the household of faith led by the Spirit of God.

"One of the biggest mistakes believers can make is to assume we are not capable of fleshly behavior. We fool ourselves if we suppose that these tendencies apply only to "them". Anyone who is not striving to walk in Christian love by the power of the Holy Spirit can fall prey.

as determined by God. Of course this only has value to those who believe in God and completely trust His omniscience, omnisapience, and omnibenevolence. People who do not believe that God is all-knowing, all-wise, and all-good will not rely on the Word of God to determine for them what is right. The “right” that is determined by God is the “right” that lines up with who God is. This “right” is just, holy, merciful, faithful, compassionate, and gracious to name a few. The Word equips us to be and do “right.”

The Word equips us to know “when we are not right.” Because many people don’t know the Word of God, they have no idea how wrong they are in their living. I believe these persons would do better if they knew better or at least they would be without excuse in their wrong. Even though, when we stand before God we will not be able to claim ignorance because God has left His Word for us. We can only admit that we have chosen to ignore it.

There are those who have discovered that they are wrong but don’t know what to do to correct their wrong. It is the Word of that shows us “how to get right.” The study of the Word of God guides us back to the right path, it will set us straight when our lives have turned crooked. Only those who don’t care about being wrong aren’t excited about being set straight. To be set straight is to be made right with God and therefore able to live the way that God has designed you to live. Again, to appreciate this aspect requires that you trust God enough to believe that He only wants what is best for you and knows what is best for you.

The Word of God will help you “stay right.” God’s Word equips us to “stay right” by being our personal, perennial tutor in righteousness. There is never a time when we don’t need the Word of God to instruct us in God’s Way. To grow up spiritually is not to become independent of the Word but to realize that we are to constantly depend on the Word for guidance.

God has given us His Word in order that you and I as believers will be prepared to be right and do what is right in every situation. This preparedness, this equipping does not happen outside of studying and applying the Word of God. You cannot not apply what you don’t know and cannot know what you have not studied. I encourage you, no I implore you to take advantage of the opportunities God has given you to study the Word, that you may know the Word, and that you apply the Word in your daily living being equipped to live righteously in everything that happens to you.

*“All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work.”* (2 Timothy 3:16–17, NLT)
