Candidates **selected** for this program will complete a 16-week training program at **Wayne County Community College and DDOT.** When you complete the training, you will have earned 37 College Credit Hours at WCCC that can be applied to earning an Associates of Arts degree (60 credits required). Candidates will be required to take <u>3 drug screenings</u> during the training process, with the first given prior to acceptance into the program. Please be prepared to stay for 2-3 Hours.

Qualifications:

- Must be willing to submit to a background check and multiple drug screenings
- High School diploma/GED is required; must bring copy to the event
- Must be able to participate in long term training program
- Must have a valid driver's license and obtain a Commercial Driver's License with airbrake and passenger endorsements
- Pass Math and English assessment administered at the Career Center
