

### Where is Your Faith?

There is an exciting acrostic formed by the word "faith." The acrostic is Forsaking–All—I—Trust—Him. Many people claim to have faith, and they do, but far too often, the faith that they have is not faith in God. A suitable synonym for faith is confidence. So, to have faith in God is to have confidence in God. I believe the most challenging challenge to having faith in God is learning how to "forsake all" other objects of our faith.

We tend to have great faith in ourselves even though we must admit that we have at times disappointed ourselves. We believe that knowledge is sufficient enough to rely on. This often leaves us with the sad testimony, "I thought I knew, but I guess I didn't." I am not suggesting that we in self-doubt, cloak ourselves instead that we realize that we should place our confidence in something as fallible as our own understanding. Sometimes we put our faith in people. We place trust in the thoughts and opinions of people. These persons are often well-intentioned, but they fall short of being perfect in their advice. Others of us have placed our confidence in the things we have acquired, only to experience that things don't always operate as expected. The truth is that if

#### Truth

What is TRUTH? Truth as defined in Webster's New World Dictionary is, "I. a) being true, specific, sincerity; honesty b) conformity with fact c) reality; actual existence d) correctness; accuracy 2. that which is true 3. an established fact." Well, somewhat accurate but when the people of God search for truth we go to the source, The Word. The Bible is God's truth and "All scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do right" (2 Timothy 3:16, NLT). John 1:1 says, "In the beginning the Word already existed. The Word was with God and the Word was God." John 1:14 (KJV) states, "And the Word was made flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth." Denying the truth does not change it. What God says always stands and does not change. In the Old Testament prophets were called by God to speak His words of truth to the people but they did not listen, and they suffered. Denying the truth has consequences. The prophet Jerimiah wept because nobody would listen, and the prophet Ezekiel spoke to the people with finely polished poetic oracles speaking (or perhaps singing) them in public. He told stories with symbolic meanings, performed symbolic actions, and described extraordinary visions that he had received from God and losing and regaining his ability to speak in the process. Ezekiel also had to lay on his side 390 days on the right side and 40 days on his left side just to get the people of Judah to listen and turn back to God. John 8:31-32 (NIV) says, "if you hold to My teaching you are really My disciples. Then you will know the Truth and the Truth will set you free." The truth sets us free to live for Jesus and Jesus gives us the abundant life when we say yes to Him. "So, if the Son sets you free you will be free indeed" (John 8:36, NIV). Jesus came to set us free from the penalty of sin with His ultimate sacrifice of laying His life down on the cross at Calvary. That sacrifice shows us true love. What will we give to show Him our love? He only asks that we tell the truth, the Gospel, the good news. God does not give alternative truth, just truth. When we follow Him, He charges us to be His ambassadors of truth. Committed and sold out and saved by the truth of our confession (Romans 10:9-10).

There was an article in the Washington Post that stated, lies travel six times faster than the truth. That might be factual but when God's people give the truth, we have the power of the Holy Spirit which can dispel lies and darkness and draw men, women, and children to Jesus Christ. We must fight for the truth with tenacity, prayer, and study. The world's truth is contingent upon feelings and circumstances. It changes at the drop of a hat. To some, convenient lies are ok in a pinch to get you out of trouble. We have even given them a color (white) and call them little or small lies. Lies in the eyes of God have no size, or color they are simply just lies. We must put on truth each day which is an essential part of the whole armor of God (Ephesians 6:14), so we can stand in the evil day and witness with confidence, not fear. We waste too much time trying to be popular. The truth is not always popular, but it is God's way and we must follow God and His truth that gives eternal life to all those who believe in Him (John 3:16). We should witness without judgement and by all means do not ram the Gospel down anyone's throat. Just tell the Good News with love in your heart, prayer, and sincerity letting the Holy Spirit have His way. God will confirm His word with signs following (see Mark 16:20, KJV). "Teach me Thy way, O Lord; I will walk in Thy truth: unite my heart to fear Thy name. I will praise Thee O Lord my God, with all my heart: and I will glorify Thy name for evermore" (Psalms 86:11-12). God bless you and keep you safe!

# Writer's Ministry Article Unity and One Accord for Kingdom Purposes

"Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of Our Lord, Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there are no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind in the same judgment" (1 Corinthians 1:10, NKJV).

Amid a worldwide Covid-19 health crisis, there is political, social, and civil unrest creating great division in our land. Our government has been consistently divided on which direction the country should proceed on several issues. Likewise, the church has had its share of division on a smaller scale. However, our local church ought to be different: we have the Love of God and the Word of God as our guiding compass of principles, values, and standard of behavior. How important it is that we first know and believe the sound and true doctrine of God's Word. After gaining some understanding, it is our duty to commit to working and gathering on one accord as a unified body.

"We should not eliminate diversity, but instead have unity of all parts like a quilt with various colors and patterns, blended beautifully together as a whole" (Bible Knowledge Commentary). Even in the midst of diversity, having single-minded Christian purposes, agreement on essentials of the faith and the Gospel, and harmony in relationships and attitudes would allow us to be more perfectly joined together to benefit the church and please God (see 1 Corinthians 1:10 printed above).

In 1 Corinthians 1:10, Paul writes to correct the disunity that occurs when the disciples identify their ministry purpose through one of the prominent Christian leaders (Paul, Apollos, or Cephas, 1 Corinthians 1:12) instead of Christ. Paul leaves no doubt as to the One he believed should be the focus of Corinthian unity. That is Jesus Christ. We, too, must fully fix and center our focus on Christ. We cannot go wrong in Him.

Paul pleaded for an outward expression that comes from an inward committed spirit. He encouraged the Corinthians to speak the same thing and allow for "no divisions among you" and **be perfectly joined together**. There is a difference between having opposing viewpoints and being divisive. Believers can work together harmoniously if they **agree on what truly matters** - Jesus Christ as Lord of all.

In the book of Acts, the early church gathered together in the upper room tarrying as Jesus instructed. **They continued with one accord in prayer and supplication** after the ascension of Jesus. United with one mind and purpose devoted to prayer, God sent the Holy Spirit as promised (see Acts 1:14; 2:1-21). February's prayer focus for Tabernacle is that we will be in unity and on one accord for kingdom purposes.

What are some kingdom purposes? Our church mission statement is a very good example. It is listed as follows: **Exalt the Savior** through worship and prayer. **Expound the scriptures** through biblical preaching and teaching. **Embrace the saved** through membership and fellowship. **Evangelize the sinner** through the sharing of the good news empowered by the Holy Spirit. **Encourage the struggling** through ministry for the whole family. **Equip the saints** through Christian education and discipleship for the work of the ministry.

Prayer: Father God, please help the members of our church to talk and behave in such a way that will reduce arguments and divisions, while increasing harmony and fellowship. Knit us together in love. Create in us the unity of purpose as guided by the Spirit of God which advances the Kingdom of Our God and Christ. Hear our prayer. Amen.

we hold on to what will eventually fail us, we will ultimately fail.

So what is a person to do? Well, the acrostic states my claim, "I trust Him!" I trust "Him," the antecedent for the pronoun Him is God. I trust God! I rely on, my confidence is in, and my faith is in God. To rely on, place your confidence in, and have faith in must be without reservation. It does us no good at all to only trust God partially; we must trust Him without reservation. We must trust God when we can't see how things will work out. We can do this because God can see what we can't see. He alone sees the end from the beginning. We must trust God when things look impossible because nothing is impossible with God.

I encourage you to place your faith in God. God will never fail you. He is perfect in all His ways. He is the only One that you can have complete confidence in. There is nothing that He does not know, for He is omniscient. There is nowhere where He is not, for He is omnipresent. There is nothing too hard for Him, for He is omnipotent. He will never be unwise in His dealings, for He is omnispaient. There is no good thing He would withhold from them that love Him because he is omnibenevolent. These are just a few reasons why I have placed my faith in Him and why you should also.

My prayer concerning my faith and yours is stated by the words of the great hymn "O for A Faith that Will Not Shrink" written by William H. Bathurst.

O for a faith that will not shrink tho pressed by many a foe, that will not tremble on the brink of any earthly woe.

That will not murmur nor complain beneath the chast'ning rod, but in the hour of grief or pain will lean upon its God.

A faith that shines more bright and clear when tempests rage without, that, when in danger, knows no fear, in darkness feels no doubt.


Lord, give me such a faith as this, and then, whate'er may come, I'll taste e'en now the hallowed bliss of an eternal home.
