

Reflect and Respond!

Lent is a time of reflection. We reflect on the greatest gift ever given. The Bible states: *“For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life”* (John 3:16, NKJV). You and I are the beneficiaries of a giving God. God gave us His best, His only begotten Son, Jesus Christ. This gift that we received freely was a costly gift. The cost was the very life of Jesus. No amount of words can adequately describe the full nature of this gift. This gift grants to us to redemption, regeneration, and reconciliation. This gift has delivered us from condemnation and eternal damnation. This gift frees us from eternal death and gives us eternal life. Paul calls this gift *“God’s unspeakable gift.”* We should utilize this Lenten season to reflect on and respond to our giving God by imitating Him in our daily lives.

Dialogue With an "Unbeliever"

Do you know that God loves you with an everlasting love? That sounds like forever. It is. God created us in His image for His good purpose and continues His faithfulness to us. He has a plan for our life and wants us to live according to His divine standards which are in the Bible. God also desires to have a personal relationship with us.

What would prevent us from having a personal relationship with God? Our sinful nature prevents us from having a personal relationship with a Holy God. It is a mind set on living according to what our flesh desires, rather than living according to how God desires for us to live. We are spiritually separated from God and incapable of living up to His standards. When there is separation there is no fellowship with God.

That might sound like it is impossible to please God. You might ask, "What must I do to have fellowship with God? How can I escape the penalty for sin?"

Those are good questions. The only way we can escape the penalty of sin and be reconciled with God, is through His Son, whose name is Jesus. Jesus Christ is God's only provision for our sin. Under no other name can we be saved from His judgment (Acts 4:12). Luke 19:10 says, "For the Son of Man came to seek and to save what was lost." John 3:16 says, "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him shall not perish, but have everlasting life."

Jesus took on the sins of the world when He died on the cross. His shed blood brings forgiveness of all our sins and saves us from the penalty of sin. Jesus was resurrected and ascended into Heaven with all power in His hand and sits at the right hand of God, interceding on our behalf. He will return to receive those of us who are in Christ and we will dwell with Him forever. Jesus is truly a gift from God.

You might wonder, if all you have to do is believe in Jesus? God will draw you unto Jesus (John 6:44) and the Holy Spirit will convict your heart of sin (John 16:8). Once you make the decision to accept Jesus as Lord and Savior, the Holy Spirit of God will come and dwell in you and you will be born again. It is the transforming power of the Holy Spirit that will change your life and produce Christ-like character in you. You will be reconciled into a genuine personal relationship with God. The Word of God will renew your mind. Your entire life will change, you will no longer want to do what is displeasing to God, but you will desire to live a Spirit filled life that is pleasing and acceptable unto Him. You will experience His unconditional love, His unspeakable joy, and the Peace of God that surpasses all understanding.

Pray with us: Gracious God our Heavenly Father, we know that You are patient and do not want anyone to perish but want everyone to come to repentance. So we lift up unbelievers to you. We pray that the Holy Spirit will convict them of their sinful state and reveal to them their need of a Savior and that they would repent of their sins and that You will draw them unto Jesus.

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth (Acts 1:8).

"Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving (Colossians 2:6-7, ESV).

Since we have received Christ as our Lord and Savior, our response should be to walk in Him, not just any kind of way, but rooted and built up. Not only this, but also established in faith and trust in God. Our walk refers to how we live our Christian lives. You may have noticed giant uprooted trees decades old lying helpless on the sidewalk, street, or on someone's house or lawn after a storm. Then, on the other hand small shrubs remain stable and upright. What is the difference? The answer is a strong and deep root system. Sadly, a number of Christians are not deeply rooted trees or strong shrubs but dried brown tumbleweeds that are blown from place to place by life problems, or every wind of doctrine or by individuals with the latest persuasive message (Ephesians 4:14).

Paul explicitly says that our rooting is in Christ. We are to seek a deep abiding relationship in Christ for He is the vine and we are the branches. We are nurtured by Him and His Word. We are also energized and strengthened by His Word. It is essential to stay in His Word *"so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith—that you, being rooted and grounded in love..."* (Ephesians 3:17-19). Seriously living out God's Word along with a committed relationship with Him will deeply root us so that we can live vibrant spiritual lives as a community of believers. We are talking about the overall strength of the church. Strong winds, tornadoes, or false doctrines will not be able to uproot us. Living our lives rooted in Christ is to be strongly secured. We can stand during the vicissitudes of life if we trust and lean on God.

TRUSTING AND LEANING!

Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make straight your paths (Proverbs 3:5-6).

The average chair can hold over 300 pounds. But how many of us actually consider this fact when we have a sit down? For many of us, this never crosses our minds. We just trust that the chair we choose will support us. And how many times do we question if our deposits will still be in our savings accounts if we don't make any withdrawals? We have come to just trust that our money will be there when we need it. When it comes to our spiritual lives, God expects an even greater reliance on Him! Often, it becomes commonplace in our lives for us to trust things in life that don't matter. But our greater need is to trust our God with reckless abandon—that means without giving any thought to any consequences. Complete dependence on Him.

We must continue to be rooted and built up in Christ. How do we do this you may ask? Simply by putting our faith and trust in Him. It sounds simple, but the truth is: trusting and depending on God is a committed act of the will, because life will surely happen. We will experience letdowns and setbacks, loss of jobs, loss of loved ones, and sometimes a loss of our physical health. It is through these challenges, however, that we can see God in more powerful ways if we are obedient to heed. In Proverbs 3:5-6, the writer of Proverbs gives us an imperative to trust in God with ALL our hearts. This means leaving no room for doubt or second-guessing. This means looking to God to supply our every need, knowing that He knows exactly what we need. Proverbs 3 further implores us to not only trust God, but, also, NOT lean to our own understanding. That is; not operate from our own power! God wants to be our only power source! We sometimes spend a great deal of time attempting to "figure things out" when God has all the answers we want and need ready for us if we just stop, listen, and wait patiently for His guidance. We must be willing to put Him first in our decision making, and allow Him to direct us! God knows exactly where He wants us to go and what He wants us to do! He only requires that we trust and lean on Him! This is what our church theme for the year 2021 is all about **"Living by Faith."**

PRAYER

Lord just as we have received You, let us continue to live and grow to spiritual maturity. May our daily conduct reflect You in our lives. Deepen our love for You and one another. Our continuous prayer is that we will be like "a tree planted by streams of water, which yield its fruit in its season and its leaf does not wither but prospers" (Psalm 1:3). In Jesus' name, we pray. Amen.

of great technological advancement. This advancement has brought forth many “time-saving” devices. Yet, we find ourselves with less time for God. We should find time to serve God by taking advantage of ministry opportunities. You and I can offer God our talents, our skills, the things we do well. It is God who has endowed you with talents and enabled you to develop and refine those talents. You can present your professional skills to God. Our talents and skills can be used to advance the kingdom of God. We also can give God our treasure. If we say that our hearts belong to God, then according to scripture our treasure should be there. *“Don’t store up treasures here on earth, where moths eat them and rust destroys them, and where thieves break in and steal. Store your treasures in heaven, where moths and rust cannot destroy, and thieves do not break in and steal. Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be”* (Matthew 6:19–21, NLT). The apostle Paul challenges us with these words: *“So here’s what I want you to do, God helping you: Take your everyday, ordinary life—your sleeping, eating, going-to-work, and walking-around life—and place it before God as an offering. Embracing what God does for you is the best thing you can do for Him”* (Romans 12:1, The Message).

As you reflect and respond this Lenten season on what God has given us through Jesus Christ, consider the words of this great hymn.

Give of Your Best to the Master

Throw your soul’s fresh, glowing ardor Into the battle for truth.

Give Him your loyal devotion, Give Him the best that you have.


Give of your best to the Master; Give Him first place in your heart;
