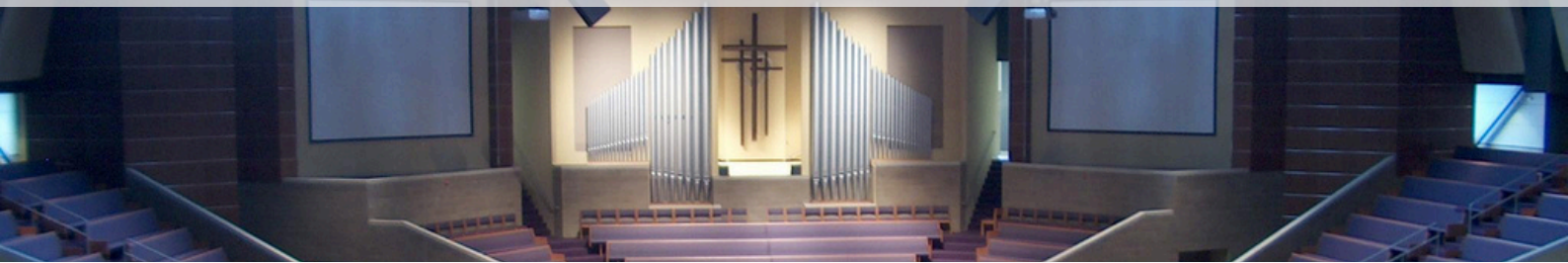

DAY 1

GOD'S SOVEREIGN CONTROL

Psalm 2:1-12

Devotional:

In a world that often seems chaotic and out of control, Psalm 2 reminds us of God's ultimate sovereignty. Just as Pastor emphasized that "God is still in control," this psalm portrays God as unshaken by the world's tumult. Reflect on areas in your life where you feel things are spiraling out of control. How might embracing God's sovereignty bring you peace?

Application:

Consider how you can surrender your worries and plans to God today, trusting in His supreme authority and perfect will.



DAY 2

THE FUTILITY OF OPPOSING GOD

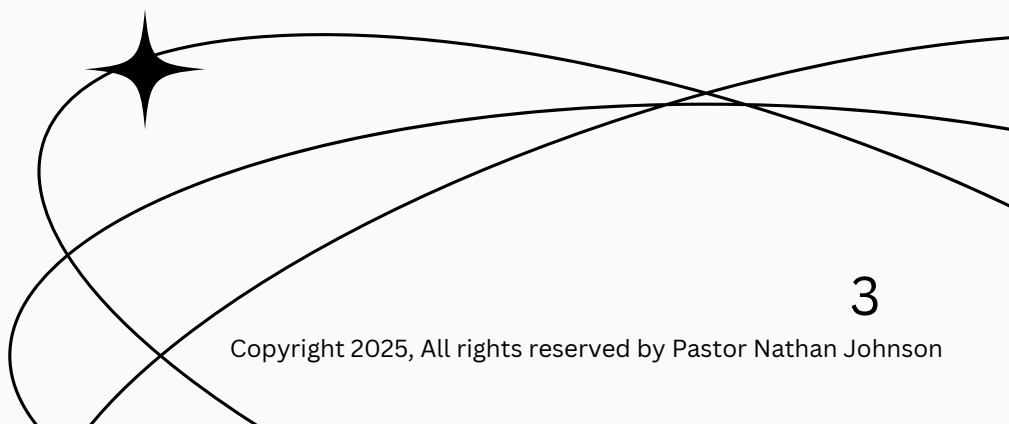
Isaiah 40:12-31

Devotional:

Isaiah 40 echoes the theme of God's incomparable power and wisdom. Pastor spoke about the "foolishness" of thinking we can outthink or outrun God. As you read, meditate on God's vastness compared to human limitations. How often do we, like the nations described, try to assert our independence from God?

Application:

Reflect on times when you've tried to live life on your own terms, only to find yourself frustrated. How can acknowledging God's supremacy lead to true freedom and peace in your life?





DAY 3

JESUS AS THE ONLY WAY

John 14:1-14

Devotional:

The sermon emphasized the exclusivity of Christ as the way to salvation. Jesus' words in John 14:6, "I am the way, the truth, and the life," reinforce this crucial doctrine. In a world that often promotes many paths to God, how can we lovingly yet firmly stand for this truth? Reflect on your own journey of faith. How has Jesus proven Himself to be "the way" in your life?

Application:

Consider how you can share this truth with others in a compassionate and compelling manner.



DAY 4

GOD'S PRESENCE IN SUFFERING

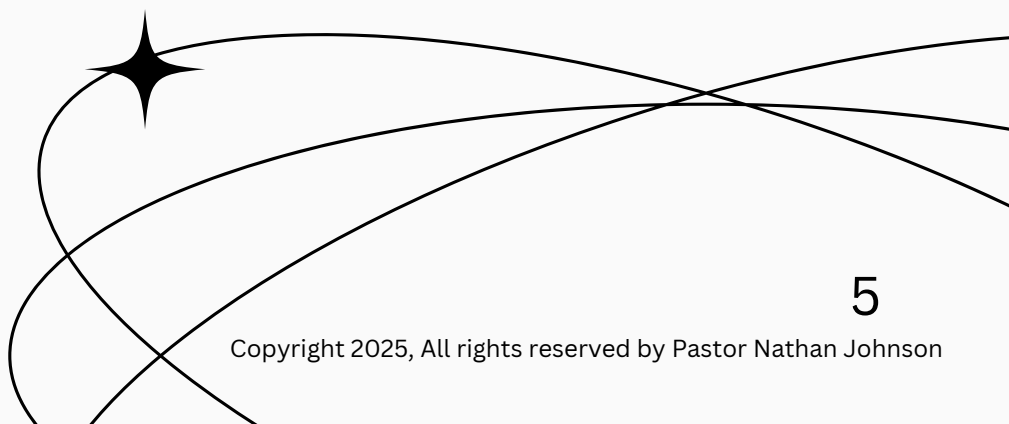
Romans 8:18-39

Devotional:

Pastor touched on God's presence even in times of natural disasters and personal struggles. Romans 8 beautifully articulates how nothing can separate us from God's love, even in our deepest sufferings. As you read, reflect on times when you've felt God's presence in your darkest moments. How has suffering deepened your faith?

Application:

Take time to pray for those currently facing trials, that they might experience God's comforting presence and unwavering love.





DAY 5

THE CALL TO GENUINE WORSHIP

John 4:19-26

Devotional:

The sermon emphasized the importance of reverent, genuine worship. Jesus' conversation with the Samaritan woman reveals that true worship goes beyond outward expressions to a matter of "spirit and truth." Reflect on your own approach to worship. Are there times when your worship becomes routine or performance-oriented rather than heartfelt? How can you cultivate a spirit of authentic adoration in your daily life?

Application:

Consider practical ways to make your entire life an act of worship to God.
