DAY 1

GOD'S UNWAVERING RIGHTEOUSNESS

Psalm 145:17-21

Devotional:

Today's reading reminds us that "The Lord is righteous in all his ways and faithful in all he does." In a world where people often let us down, it's comforting to know that God's character never changes. He is always just, always loving, always faithful.

Application:

Reflect on times when you've experienced God's righteousness in your life. How has His consistency brought you peace? Today, strive to mirror God's righteousness in your own actions, treating others with fairness and kindness, even when it's challenging.



DAY 2

THE GOD WHO REACHES OUT


Luke 15:1-7

Devotional:

Jesus tells the parable of the lost sheep, illustrating God's relentless pursuit of those who are lost or falling. Just as the sermon mentioned God "reaching out" to those who are falling, this parable shows us a God who actively seeks us out.

Application:

Have you ever felt like you were slipping away from God? Remember that He is always extending His hand to you. Today, be mindful of those around you who might be struggling. How can you be God's hands, reaching out to support someone in need?





DAY 3

DIVINE RESTORATION

Isaiah 40:28-31

Devotional:

Isaiah speaks of God giving strength to the weary and power to the weak. This echoes the sermon's point about God's "recovering" - how He lifts us up when we're overwhelmed.

Application:

Think about a time when you felt completely drained, physically or spiritually. How did God renew your strength? Today, if you're feeling weak, lean into God's promise of restoration. If you're feeling strong, consider how you can help bear someone else's burden, reflecting God's restoring nature.



DAY 4

GOD'S ABUNDANT PROVISION


Philippians 4:10-20

Devotional:

Paul writes about learning to be content in all circumstances, knowing that God will meet all our needs. This aligns with the sermon's discussion of God's "resourcing" - providing what we need when we need it.

Application:

Reflect on times when God has provided for you in unexpected ways. How has this shaped your faith? Challenge yourself today to trust God with an area of lack in your life, believing in His promise to provide.





DAY 5

THE ULTIMATE DEMONSTRATION OF GOD'S LOVE

Romans 3:21-26

Devotional:

This passage discusses God's righteousness being revealed through faith in Jesus Christ. It ties directly to the sermon's point about the "epitome of His righteousness" displayed through Christ's sacrifice.

Application:

Meditate on the profound truth that God pushed you back and put Christ forward to take your place. How does this display of love impact your daily life? Today, let this sacrificial love motivate you to extend grace and forgiveness to others, even when it's difficult.
