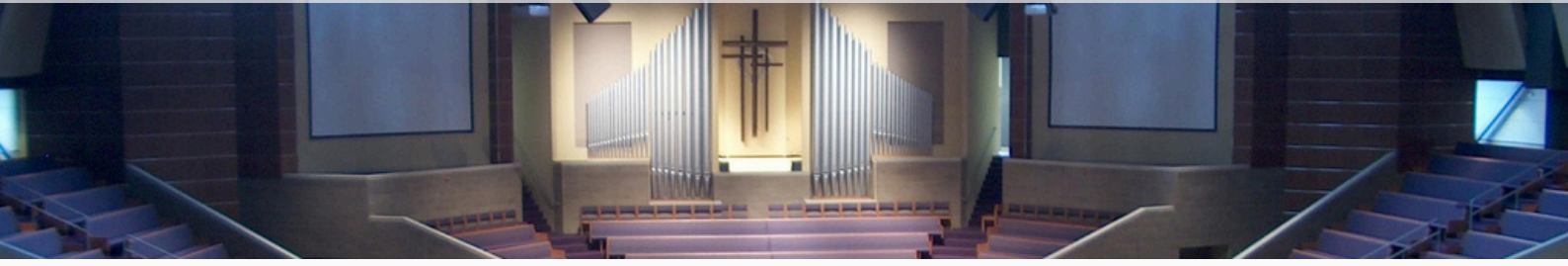

DAY 1

THE UNCHANGING NATURE OF GOD

Malachi 3:6-7, Hebrews 13:8

Devotional:

In a world of constant change, our God remains steadfast. The sermon reminds us that God declares, "I am the Lord, I do not change." This truth brings immense comfort in times of uncertainty.

Application:

Reflect on areas of your life where you've experienced change or instability. How does knowing God is unchanging impact your perspective on these situations? Consider how God's unchanging nature relates to His promises in your life. Take time to thank Him for being a constant anchor in the midst of life's storms.



DAY 2

GOD'S REFINING LOVE

Malachi 3:2-3, 1 Peter 1:6-7

Devotional:

The image of God as a refiner, purifying silver, is a powerful metaphor for His work in our lives. Just as a silversmith carefully watches the metal, removing impurities until he sees his reflection, God lovingly refines us through life's challenges.

Application:

What areas of your life might God be refining right now? How can you surrender to this process, trusting in His loving intentions? Remember, the goal is to reflect more of God's character. Pray for patience and perseverance as you go through refining moments.



DAY 3

THE TRANSFORMATIVE POWER OF CHRIST'S BLOOD

Hebrews 9:14, 1 John 1:7

Devotional:

The sermon powerfully states, "Nothing but the blood of Jesus" can wash away our sins. This profound truth is the cornerstone of our faith. Reflect on the magnitude of Christ's sacrifice and the complete cleansing it offers. Are there areas in your life where you're still holding onto guilt or shame?

Application:

Bring these before God, acknowledging the sufficiency of Christ's blood to cleanse you fully. Express your gratitude for this undeserved gift and consider how this truth should impact your daily walk with God.



DAY 4

GOD'S JUSTICE AND MERCY

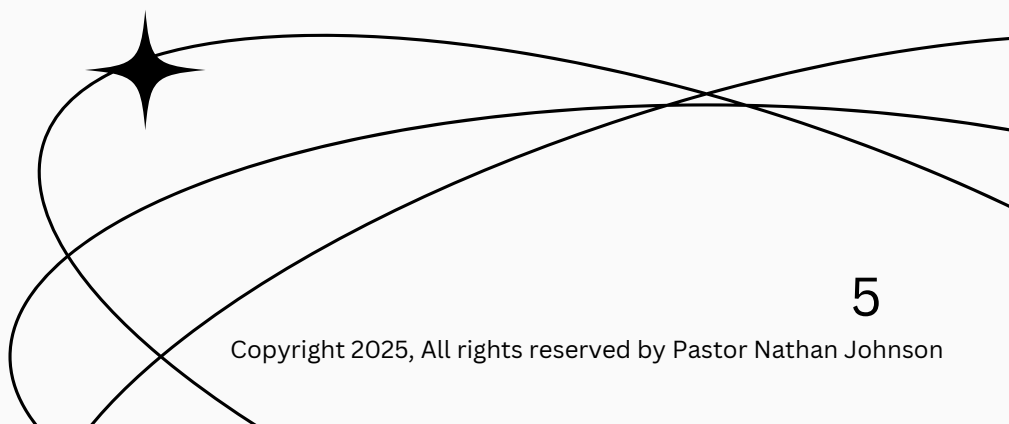
Psalm 89:14, Romans 3:23-26

Devotional:

The sermon touches on God's unwavering commitment to justice, while also emphasizing His incredible mercy. This balance is at the heart of the gospel.

Application:

Reflect on how God's justice and mercy have intersected in your own life. How has experiencing God's mercy changed your view of others who fall short? Consider ways you can extend both justice and mercy in your relationships and community, mirroring God's character. Pray for wisdom to navigate situations where both qualities are needed.





DAY 5

FINDING COMFORT IN GOD'S PRESENCE

Psalms 46:1-3, 2 Corinthians 1:3-4

Devotional:

The sermon describes God as our "way out of nowhere" and "bridge over troubled waters." In life's darkest moments, God's presence is our ultimate comfort.

Application:

Recall a time when you tangibly felt God's presence in difficulty. How did it change your perspective? If you're currently facing challenges, invite God's comforting presence into your situation. Remember, He is not distant but intimately involved in our lives. Close by meditating on God's promise to never leave or forsake you, allowing His peace to fill your heart.
