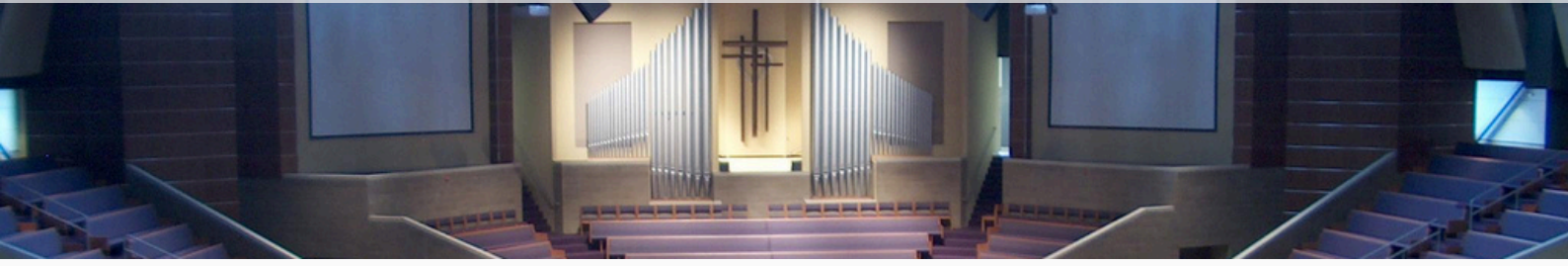

# DAY 1

## THE WISDOM OF GOD

Proverbs 3:13-20

### **Devotional:**

God's wisdom surpasses all human understanding. As we read in the sermon, "God's wisdom puts Him in a class all by Himself." Today, reflect on areas in your life where you need divine wisdom.

### **Application:**

How might trusting in God's perfect knowledge and timing change your perspective on current challenges? Remember, God "knows perfectly what to do with all that He knows perfectly." Pray for the humility to seek God's wisdom above your own understanding.



# DAY 2

## GOD'S PERFECT TIMING

### **Ecclesiastes 3:1-8**

#### **Devotional:**

The sermon reminds us that "God is never too early and never too late." In a world that demands instant gratification, waiting on God's timing can be challenging. Consider a situation in your life where you're anxious for an answer or resolution.

#### **Application:**

How might trusting in God's perfect timing bring you peace? Reflect on past experiences where God's timing, though different from your own, proved to be perfect. Ask for the grace to wait patiently and trust in His divine schedule.



# DAY 3

## THE POWER OF GOD'S WORD

### **2 Timothy 3:14-17**

#### **Devotional:**

"All Scripture is given by inspiration of God and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness." The sermon emphasizes the sufficiency and power of God's Word in our lives. Today, examine your relationship with Scripture.

#### **Application:**

Are you relying on God's Word as your primary source of guidance and truth? Challenge yourself to spend more time in the Bible, allowing it to shape your thoughts, decisions, and actions. Pray for a renewed hunger for God's Word and the wisdom to apply it to your daily life.



# DAY 4

## GOD'S SOVEREIGN SUPERVISION

### **Romans 8:28-30**

#### **Devotional:**

"God sees everything... It means it's either something he ordained or something he permits." This powerful reminder of God's sovereignty can bring comfort in difficult times. Reflect on a challenging situation in your life.

#### **Application:**

How might viewing it through the lens of God's sovereign supervision change your perspective? Remember, God can "take even the jagged pieces of life and so synergize them together that it works out for my good." Ask God to help you trust His oversight in all aspects of your life.



# DAY 5

## THE WISDOM OF REDEMPTION

### **1 Corinthians 1:18-25**

#### **Devotional:**

The sermon highlights that God's redemptive plan "displays most brilliantly his wisdom." Meditate on the profound truth that God's plan for salvation was in place even before creation.

#### **Application:**

How does this demonstrate God's love and foresight? Consider your own journey of faith - how has God's redemptive work transformed your life? Take time to thank God for His wise and loving plan of salvation, and pray for opportunities to share this good news with others who need to hear it.
